





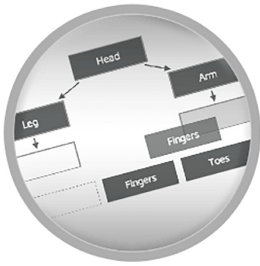

Sequential Reasoning
