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Capstone certification description

The Woods capstone assesses candidates' progression from foundational woodworking skills to advanced craftsmanship and production practices. Woods 1 introduces core competencies such as layout, shaping, assembly, and finishing, with an emphasis on safe use of tools and machinery as well as craftsmanship and design principles. Woods 2 expands on these skills by evaluating advanced techniques, manufacturing processes, and design in a production setting. Woods 3 culminates in mastery-level skills, emphasizing advanced craftsmanship, production methods, and widely accepted design principles. Together, the certifications validate readiness for technical careers in woodworking, furniture design, and construction-related industries.
